

ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU

- 1. All health insurance cards.
- 2. Your most recent eyeglasses.
- 3. A complete list of your current medications.
- 4. Referral forms from your primary care physician if your health insurance plan requires prior approval.
- 5. A completed and signed insurance form if you have private commercial insurance.
- 6. Completed medical questionnaire, if provided.



Your complete consultation will last about **two hours**. Please take all pills, injections, and eye drops as you normally would on the day of your appointment. Eat a light to moderate breakfast or lunch prior to your visit unless specifically informed not to eat anything prior to your appointment. Both of your eyes will be dilated with eye drops that may cause you to be light sensitive for up to 12 hours. For this reason, you may wish to bring sunglasses and someone to drive you home. If you do not have sunglasses, they will be provided to you.
